



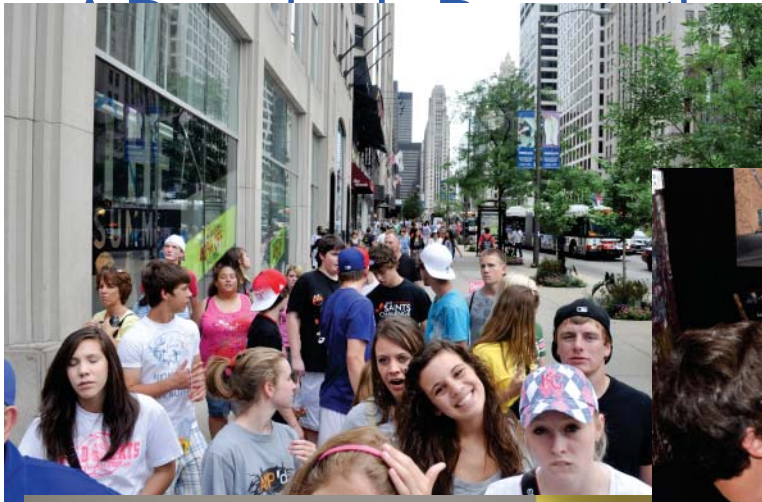

If you have any craft supplies that you don't need, please consider donating them to our Teacher's Workroom. See Cindy Drumheller or Julie Dean with questions.

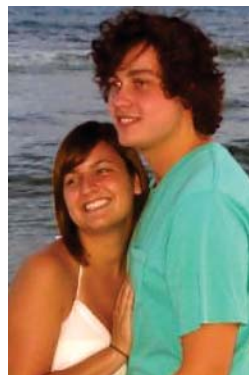
Annual Meeting Notice
