What wonderful things God may do through this. There may be another Soledad waiting to be saved.

Today, Blake Mullins will share a little bit about his experiences so far and his plans to return. Blake is one of those young men who delights our souls and we are so pleased to partner with him to be with Jarrod and Ally.

God is good, and we are rich because of His love. Thank you for my great blessings as a minister to you. I'm learning to love you more and more.
