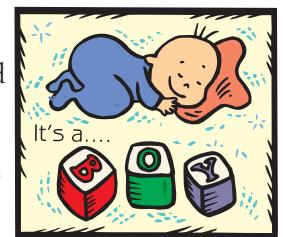


## Small Group Fellowships
